- Have a conversation with decision makers about what the findings mean for your library
- Keep asking library patrons about how they benefit from products and services provided by your library

- Which report formats will work best with those venues?
- Who will be prepared to make presentations about our ROI results?
- Who is interested in this information? Why should they care?
