Colorado Historic Newspapers Collection 2022 Fast Facts

The Colorado Historic Newspapers Collection (CHNC) currently provides free access to 2.7 million digitized pages representing over 635 individual newspaper titles published in Colorado from 1859 up through 2022.

Quick Stats:

- Over 600 thousand pages added since July 2021
- CHNC includes content in 8 languages including English, German, Italian, Japanese, Slavic, Spanish, Serbian, and Swedish
- Over 175 individual and organizational contributors assist with content, funding, or text correction.
- There were over 2.8 million pageviews in 2022.

Page counts were reported in July each year and users were reported in November.
