Study and Meeting Spaces in Colorado Public Libraries

In Colorado, 209 library locations reported offering meeting or study room spaces. Of these libraries, 112 reported both types of spaces (53.6%), 85 reported only meeting rooms (40.7%), and (5.7%) reported only study rooms.

Eight locations had 10 or more meeting rooms. One location had 10 or more study rooms.

The total number of study and meeting rooms in Colorado public libraries is as follows: 544 meeting rooms 335 study rooms

In 2023, for the locations that reported room usage, the average study room was used over twice as many times as the average meeting room. Meeting rooms were used on average 286 times and study rooms were used on average 663 times.

The location with the busiest study rooms was Parker Library (located in Douglas County) with an average of 2,111 uses per room.

The location with the busiest meeting room was Baily Public Library (located in Park County) with 2,977 uses per room.
